

HOW TO GET CME CREDIT

In order to receive a certificate (and CME credit), you must submit an evaluation for each lecture attended. You can submit your evaluation(s) one of two ways:

- 1 Use the links that will be sent to you at the end of each day.
- 2 Use the QR codes found in this book.

Here are instructions on how to use the QR codes.



Use a smart phone to scan the QR Code located at the bottom of each page to access the evaluation for that particular lecture.

Each lecture has it's own evaluation and QR code, EXCEPT for the Panel Discussions. You will access all three evaluations for each panel discussion using the same QR code.

If you don't have a smart phone, don't worry! Links to each evaluation will be sent out at the end of each day.

You'll receive a confirmation email after you submit each evaluation.

You're always welcome to visit the registration table to check the number of evaluations you've submitted or email AKingsley@OsteopathicFounders.org to confirm your hours.

You'll need to answer the following multiple choice questions for each lecture:

- Qualify your knowledge level of the applicable topic before and after the lecture.
- How would you rate the speaker and presentation overall?
- Did the educational activity accomplish the specified objectives?
- Was the presenter knowledgeable of the topic and well-prepared?
- Were speaker disclosures clear?
- Was the presentation free of commercial bias?
- List one thing learned from the lecture. (Your answer will need to be in the form of a sentence.)
- How will you consider changing your practice as a result of attending this educational activity?

DON'T FORGET: An evaluation must be submitted for each lecture you attend.

At the conclusion of the symposium, you will also receive a link for a program evaluation so that you may provide additional feedback about the venue, the agenda, the food, the exhibitors, etc. While this evaluation is not required, it will help us plan for future symposiums.
